Do I need to fill out all of this? No. You do need to fill in every grey background cell in the table. Otherwise I will not be able to give proper credit for the race. Try to fill out everything at the top of the page if you can, but the only completely crucial information is to indicate if pitting is being used or not (I will assume not).

What is Type? If this is a single race that is not part of a series or tournament, then circle "one-off." If this is part of a tournament or series of races, the other options apply. Exactly what you select from the other options does not matter much other than to help me tell this race from others in the same series or tournament.

What is Configuration Year (next to track)? Most racing circuits of any age go through changes over the years and I have modeled multiple iterations of many of those tracks. The configuration year is the first year that a track was raced on in F1. That information can be found on my web site. If the track is not one of mine, I've probably indicated somewhere how to list it.

Driver: Try to include as much of the person's name as you can.

Super License # or Email: Every driver who has raced in a CFR event over the last number of years should have a CFR Super License #. If they are new or forgot their #, enter their email here. I use this information in conjunction with their name to correctly identify which CFR driver this is.

Obviously, you only need to fill out data for the drivers that participate. If you have more than 12 drivers in the race, you can use the fields below, but note that this is not recommended unless there is pitting.

Finish: Note that "dnf" or some other similar note should be used for cars that do not finish the race. If 1 car in a 9 car field crashes, do not write down 9 for that car, write down DNF. The difference is that DNF's never get points for a race, 9th place would.
